Special Council Meeting Minutes
(Purchase of City Police Vehicle)

Thursday, July 22, 2021, 5:05 p.m.

A special meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of St. Paul, Nebraska was held at City Hall in said City on Thursday, July 22, 2021 at 5:05 p.m. Present were Mayor Joel Bergman and Councilmembers: Jerry Thompson, Katie Kowalski, Chuck Schmid and Mike Feeken. Absent: none. Notice of the meeting was posted in four (4) public places. Notice of this meeting was communicated in the advance notice. All proceeds thereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was opened to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Bergman opened the special meeting at 5:08 p.m., thanking the public for attending and announcing that the City of St. Paul abides by the Open Meetings Act, which is posted on the west wall as required by Nebraska State Law §84-1407 through §84-1414. Mayor Bergman also stated that the City Council may vote to go into Closed Session on any agenda item as allowed by NE State Law §84-1410.


The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and possibly approve the purchase of a used City Police vehicle.

Council member Feeken moved to approve purchasing a 2016 Ford Police Interceptor via online auction at a bid up to \$22,600. If the City is not successful in purchasing this vehicle by online auction, the Police Chief is authorized to spend up to \$22,600 on a similar Police Interceptor vehicle. Council member Kowalski seconded the motion. Council members Kowalski, Thompson, Schmid & Feeken voting aye, nays none. Motion carried 4/0.


There was no further business to come before this session of the Council.

Mayor Bergman adjourned the special meeting at 5:18 p.m.
